

WORK & PUBLIC PLACE



- Installing auditory feedback in traffic signals

- Emergency Exits
- Dedicated washroom/parking places
- . Separate space for wheelchairs and other walking aids

 Awareness generation / develop & disseminate Health Education, IEC material for various programs of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.


School Health Education division
